DETAILS

The main aim of this project was to provide a new improved access road for the proposed Morrisons Supermarket and surrounding retail stores. This would involve the widening of the existing road (whilst maintaining access for all surrounding businesses), forming of a new access for delivery vehicles, new pedestrian crossing and construction of a new roundabout with associated lighting and signage. All works were carried out in accordance with current Highways agency specifications and under the supervision of Anglesey County Council Highways department. Hollingsworth Bros were responsible for dealing with all relevant licences/road openings etc, and also liaising with utility providers regarding diversions.

Construction Specification/Details

Crib retaining wall adjacent to the new roundabout was constructed using interlocking timber sections and then planted to tie in with current surroundings. This element of work was carried out on behalf of Hollingsworth Bros by specialist contractor RPC.

The new Roundabout was constructed using traditional half Battered kerbs forming the main radius of the roundabout, the centre of the roundabout was then filled forming a batter from the back of the kerb, this batter was then paved using specially manufactured paving with a reflective black and white block paviours giving the "Chevron" effect. The centre of the roundabout was then finished with a locally sourced slate product.

The Main Carriageway was constructed using traditional surfacing methods and to Highways and IOACC specifications, this element of work was carried out on behalf of Hollingsworth Bros by Hogan Bros surfacing.

Specialist Anti Skid surfacing was applied to all approaches of the roundabout and also at the approach to the newly installed pedestrian crossing, this work was carried out by L&R road markings.

All earthworks, drainage, ducting, kerbing and formations were carried out by our own team of skilled workforce. All of whom are trained to current New Roads And Streetworks Act, including supervision level.

Pedestrian Crossing was installed and commissioned on behalf of Hollingsworth Bros by SIEMENS UK, builders work for the crossing was carried out by Hollingsworth Bros, this involved some works out of hours to avoid disruption to local businesses whilst excavating across the existing carriageway.

New Street lighting and signage was installed by IOACC approved contractors BETHELL under the guidance of H Bros management.

PROGRAMME.

The original programme of 14wks was completed 1 week ahead of schedule with IOACC taking possession of the roads and placing onto maintenance 2 weeks later with minimal snags.

CLIENT SATISFACTION

All works were carried out with zero complaints from local residents/businesses and the new road was ready for use on the opening day of the new store to the satisfaction of Wm Morrisons IOACC also carried out a stage 3 safety survey of the works upon completion with zero defects to the satisfaction of our client Pettifer.
