OBJECTIVE

This project was the focus of a major upgrading of the RFD Beaufort site at Birkenhead. The previous main reception had little impact for visiting UK and worldwide visitors. Along with KKA architects the below was to be transformed.



Internally the client requested utilizing new branding colours to provide a fresh modern reception and waiting area. The project set out with a limited budget and an optimistic delivery date, this date was due to a senior visitor from the parent company attending site.





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METHOD

Foundations and a structural steelwork formed the new frame that improves the aspect of the frontage. This was clad with block work and diaphragm timber box beams formed the roof structure and subsequent zinc panels both externally and internally.

Internally the entire area was stripped back. A floating ceiling with up-lighting was introduced as an alternative to costly roof lights. New finishes were introduced to complement the bespoke, modern reception desk and sprayed mdf feature wall

RESULTS

The completed project provides the ideal balance between durability and aesthetic qualities. The Cladding frontage is a natural zinc product with faceted glazing exhibits a striking focus for local passing trade

The waiting area is strikingly decorated in the company corporate colour scheme
